1. Call to Order

With a quorum of the City Council members present, Mayor Thompson called the special meeting of the Garden Ridge City Council to order at 6:01 p.m. on Thursday, May 10, 2018, in the City Council Chambers of the Garden Ridge City Hall, 9400 Municipal Parkway, Garden Ridge, Texas 78266.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

Mayor Thompson led the pledge of allegiance.

3. Citizen Comment Period

Ken Kneupper, 8891 Schoenthal Road, stated the Council must be doing something right because the City has cancelled their elections for the past four years.

4. Business Items

The following items are for discussion, consideration and action.

- a) Canvass the May 5, 2018 General Election - Ordinance 211- 032018, passed and approved on March 7, 2018, declared Unopposed Candidates for Places 1, 4, and 5 in the City Council May 5, 2018, General City Election, elected to the office, and canceled the Election.
 - i. Issue the Certificates of Election and Administer Oaths of Office to John McCaw for City Council, Place 1, Todd Arvidson for City Council, Place 4, and Kay Bower for City Council, Place 5.

Mayor Thompson issued the Certificate of Election and administered the Oath of Office to John McCaw for City Council, Place 1.

Mayor Thompson issued the Certificate of Election to Todd Arvidson for City Council, Place 4. Virginia Arvidson, his wife, administered the Oath of Office for Councilmember Place 4 to Todd Arvidson.

Mayor Thompson issued the Certificate of Election to Kay Bower for City Council, Place 5. Jim Bower, her husband administered the Oath of Office for Councilmember Place 5 to Kay Bower.

b) Election of Mayor Pro-tem for a one year period expiring May 2019.

Mayor Thompson stated Mayor Pro-Tem McCaw has volunteered to serve another term as Mayor Pro-Tem.

Motion: A motion was made by Councilmember Bower, seconded by Councilmember Lantzy, to reappoint Councilmember McCaw as Mayor Pro-Tem for a one year period expiring May 2019. The City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed. The motion carried unanimously.

c) Designation of authorized signers on bank accounts held by the City of Garden Ridge with First United Bank and TexPool.

Nancy Cain, City Administrator, stated currently the authorized signers on bank accounts held by the City of Garden Ridge are the Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, City Administrator, and City Secretary.

Motion: A motion was made by Councilmember Lantzy, seconded by Councilmember Arvidson, to keep the designation of authorized signers as Mayor, Mayor Pro-Tem, City Administrator, and City Secretary on bank accounts held by the City of Garden Ridge with First United and TexPool. The City Council voted five (5) for and none (0) opposed. The motion carried unanimously.

5. Citizen Comment Period

Tristan Arvidson, 20506 Bat Cave Road, stated “dad, you are doing a great job.”

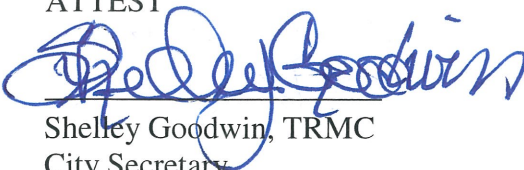
6. Adjournment
