1. Call to Order

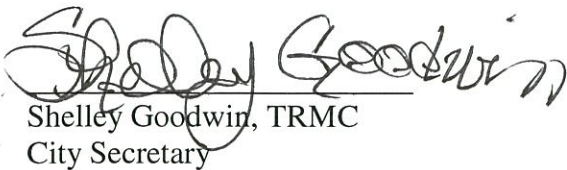
5. Adjournment
