6. **Citizen Comment Period:** No one wished to speak.

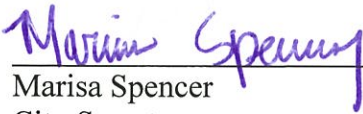
7. **Adjournment**
